Key Responsibilities:

Providing support/ attending meetings and negotiations with Sales and Marketing team in negotiations on TLAs with MSS customers.

Legal

- Able to act in place of the General Counsel/Senior Manager in managing day to day operations of Legal Department;
- Manage and supervise all personnel in the legal, regulatory section of the Legal Department on day to day operations;
- In absence of the GC, to respond to specific advice required by the CEO and other members of the Senior Management Team (SMT) on any legal as well as compliance/regulatory issues arising from time to time. To manage and liaise with external legal counsel for any required legal opinions, review of legal contracts and other legal documents, and in litigation matters;
- Overseeing ITAR issues and managing the execution of TAAs by related parties of MSS, the Group as required under satellite programs;
- Ensuring the Legal Dept provides necessary legal support and advice to other Depts on day to day operational matters;
- Oversee and supervise, advise on issues arising as part of contract management of satellite programs, and act as the main point of contact of MSS vis a vis satellite vendors, consultants and/or any third parties pursuant to contracts signed by the company;
- Oversee and review MSS financing/refinancing documents for satellite programs including coordinating advice and input from UT Tax and UT Treasury; and
- Monitoring MEASAT trademark matters.

Requirements:

- Degree holder in Law (L.L.B) or a combination of law and other disciplines, from any recognized University in Malaysia or other parts of the world;
- Advanced English grammar and in legal drafting /writing /spoken skills;
- Previous work experience for at least 10 years, either in an established legal firm (Malaysia or elsewhere) or in Legal departments of local/multinational organizations in telecommunications, satellite, broadcasting industries;
- Familiar with and has intimate knowledge and experience of MSS operations/business and generally in the telecommunications industry;
- Well versed with the Communications and Multimedia Act (CMA) and its Regulations, Companies Act;

- Well versed with the listing rules of the Bursa Malaysia and relevant rules governing related party transactions;
- Experienced in and familiar with review of financing documents; and
- Mature person, possessing good negotiations, interaction and teamwork skills.
